**Title G.M. White & Co., Connecticut Boulevard, East Hartford**

Date about 1910

Medium Photography; gelatin silver print on paper on cardboard mount

Description Three men stand on a loading dock at the corner of a frame commercial building painted in contrasting colors. The man on the left appears to be African American.
