Title Bulkeley Bridge Construction: Setting Stones on Arches, East Hartford

Date before 1907

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Photography; gelatin silver print on paper

Description Four large cranes on platforms supported by pilings are being used to place blocks of Stony Creek granite on three of the arches of the Bulkeley Bridge. Hooks and pulleys hang from the cranes. Temporary wooden centering spans support the stones. Ladders lead from the platforms to the tops of the arches. One of the Leete's Island granite piers is at the left. Trees and construction sheds are on the shore. The temporary iron bridge is in the background. The Connecticut River is in the foreground.

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Dimensions Primary Dimensions (overall height x width): 7 1/16 x 9 7/16in. (18 x 24cm)
