Description Structure, possibly of brick, has dormers, a fanlight, louvered shutters at the windows, a cornice and multiple chimneys. A picket fence is to the right. A saltbox house has pedimented windows and door, and multiple

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chimneys. Trees, grass and a rail fence are in front of the house. A dirt road is in the foreground. A shadow indicates that the large building of which only a corner is visible has a steeple and is therefore probably a church.
