Title Pill Case

Primary Maker Dr. Robert Usher

Medium leather

Description Pill case designed for use in a saddlebag. There are spaces for nine pill containers. It has six, glass pill containers remaining, five labeled. Bottles labeled as *Triosteum Perfoliatum* (Feverwort), *Sepiae Succus*, *Kali Nitricum* (Nitrate of Potassium), *Silicea* (Silica Dioxide), and *Lycopodium* (Clubmoss). This was used by Dr. Robert Usher of Westchester. Has a portion of a belt to be used to attach to the saddlebag.

Dimensions Component (height x diameter of glass bottles): $2 \frac{3}{4} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (7×1.3 cm) Primary Dimensions (overall length x width of closed case): $11 \frac{3}{4} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in. (29.8×11.4 cm)
