Description A doll's tea set made of white china with gold trim. Set includes six cups and saucers, sugar bowl, creamer, and a tea pot. The top to the tea pot is broken and missing pieces. Otherwise, it is a complete set. The gold trim is faded and worn. (a-l) cups and saucers (m-n) sugar bowl and top (o) creamer (p) tea pot
