Engine-Driven Shearing Machine
For shearing sheep and goats. The ONE-MAN will shear 100 head per day without crowding. Built to any engine. Quickly set up. Easily attached to wall, cross beam or overhead with the two bracket bolts supplied. Throws in or out of gear with a push or pull at bracket end of jointed shaft. Engine keeps on running when machine is out of gear. Jointed shaft is 60 inches long. Shipping weight, 47 lbs.
