**Description** Framed black and white print of the Smith, Bourn & Co. building located at No. 123, Sigourney Street, Hartford. The print was originally published in "Atlas of Connecticut 1893." The sign on the building reads, "SMITH, BOURN & CO. / HARNESS, SADDLES AND HORSE GOODS / SALESROOMS 334 ASYLUM ST. HARTFORD / 40 WARREN ST. NEW YORK." There is an American flag on the top of the building. A railroad is seen behind the building. There are two people walking between the buildings.
