Description Color mounted slides of city views of Japan in 1952 during the Korean War. (.48) View of an urban street in Japan. On the opposite side of the road are facades of buildings with various advertising signs in Japanese. Cars and buses are seen on the street. Pedestrians are walking and some are riding bicycles. (.49) Probably a distant view of a bus station from an urban street with hills in the background. Pedestrians are seen walking on the sidewalk. (.50) A high-rise brick building in the background of an urban street. Cars and buses are stationed in front of the structure. Pedestrians are seen walking in the parking area. (.51) Urban buildings in the background of a street. A person is riding their bicycle on the street. (.52) People walking through a busy outdoor marketplace.

Basic Detail Report

Signs in Japanese are attached to the front of the buildings. A person riding a bicycle is seen on the sidewalk. (.53) An underexposed image of an alleyway. Overhead power lines are in the background. (.54) Ground view of the facade of a Japanese Temple. The wooden structure is made of five tiers with larger roof overhangs going down each level. Trees stand on both sides of the temple. (.55) An underexposed close-up ground view image of the side of the Japanese Temple. Trees are in the background. (.56) A section of a park edged with trees and benches. A building is seen behind the line of trees. (.57) An underexposed image of the ground view of a park on the grounds of the Japanese Temple. (.58) A side view of the Japanese Temple. Probably one of the entrances of the building. (.59-.62) Landscape view of a city in Japan taken from the inside of the Japanese Temple with high-rise hills in the background. The wooden endings of the tier roof are at the top of the image. (.63) A view of the Japanese Temple from a pond in the park. Trees and small buildings are in the background. (.64) An underexposed close-up view of part of a building. (.65) Probably a street view of a bus station. Cars and buses are parked in front of the building. (.66) View of a street in Japan. Buildings are seen across the street. A woman on the right is standing next to a white and green street sign.
