Description Color mounted slides of various scenes in Japan and a military camp during the Korean War, 1952-1953. (.202) View of a people on a busy public street in Japan. A male traffic guard in the front of the image with a whistle in his mouth is pointing both arms to his left. The guard is wearing a work uniform with a hat, white gloves, and glasses. Attached to each vendor and/or building are signs in Japanese. (.203-.204) A small, decorated Christmas tree stands in a military camp in front of tents. Ornaments on the tree include bells, stars, tinsel, and wreaths. High-rise hills are seen in the background. (.205) A view of people on the grass of a public park. Green trees are seen in the background. (.206)
