## Title East Quarry trackwalker and derricks

Medium Photography; nitrate negatives

Description Black and white photographic negative, view of trackwalker and derricks during the quarrying of granite Rip Rap [human-placed rock used to protect shoreline structures] for the Kelsey Point Breakwater, 1914. An unidentified John Beattie Granite Works laborer walks along steel rail tracks in the East Quarry. Hoisting derricks line the right side of the tracks with two unidentified laborers standing at the far right. The area is strewn with blocks of granite.
