Description Black and white group portrait photograph of members of the Beattie family and friends picnicking on Falkner Island, 1905. The group is posed on wooden beams surrounded by granite in two rows, those in the back stand while the front row is seated. A derrick is visible in the background. The names of the party have been inscribed on the reverse of the photograph. In the back row, standing, are [Left to Right] an unidentified woman, Katherine Gay, Grace Troop, unidentified woman, Mary G. Beattie, Louise K. Mortimore, and Dr. Fairfield Mortimore. The front row have been identified as [Left to Right] Mildred V. Beattie, Mrs. Peter Beattie, Philip Malcolm Beattie, Harold J. Beattie, Tom Beattie, Robert Beattie, and William Riley. The men are dressed in suits, some of the women wear white or light colored dresses while others wear white shirtwaists with long skirts, the young children are dressed in white.
