Description View of a group of people in wedding attire standing in a line on a path in front of a house. There is an elderly woman standing on the porch of the house. At the back of the line are Mary "Maizy" Wilcox Russell (1873-1933) being escorted by John Davenport Cheney (1870-1919). She is holding a bouquet in her free hand, and he appears to be holding a top hat in his. There is one bridesmaid standing in front of them and then two pairs of bridesmaids in front of her. All of

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them are wearing matching dresses and flower tiaras. The four in front are

holding round bouquets that have large bows on them. The group is posed on a

long carpet that has been placed over the dirt path. The photograph is mounted

on a piece of thick, dark gray cardstock.
