Description Photograph of a cased photo depicting a bust length portrait of an

older woman, possibly Harriet A. Bowen Cheney, second wife of Charles Cheney

(1803-1874). She is looking at the camera. The woman is wearing a dark dress or

blouse with a white ruffled collar peeking out from the inside. There is a circular

brooch pinned at her neck. Her hair is styled in an updo with a roll of hair at each

temple. She is wearing a white cap. The portrait is in a rectangular frame,

probably within a case. The frame has an oval mat and scrollwork in the corners.
