Purpose

The labor-management General Committee voted on January 28, 1947, to establish a fund, to be maintained by regular voluntary contributions from Allen employees, for the support of worthy organized charities in Greater Hartford. This proposal has since been approved by the Stewards, Foremen and Top Management.

Such a fund will eliminate frequent solicitations within the plant for various charities. A lot of volunteer effort and production time will thus be saved. Also, employees will be spared the embarrassment of asking or being asked for money.
