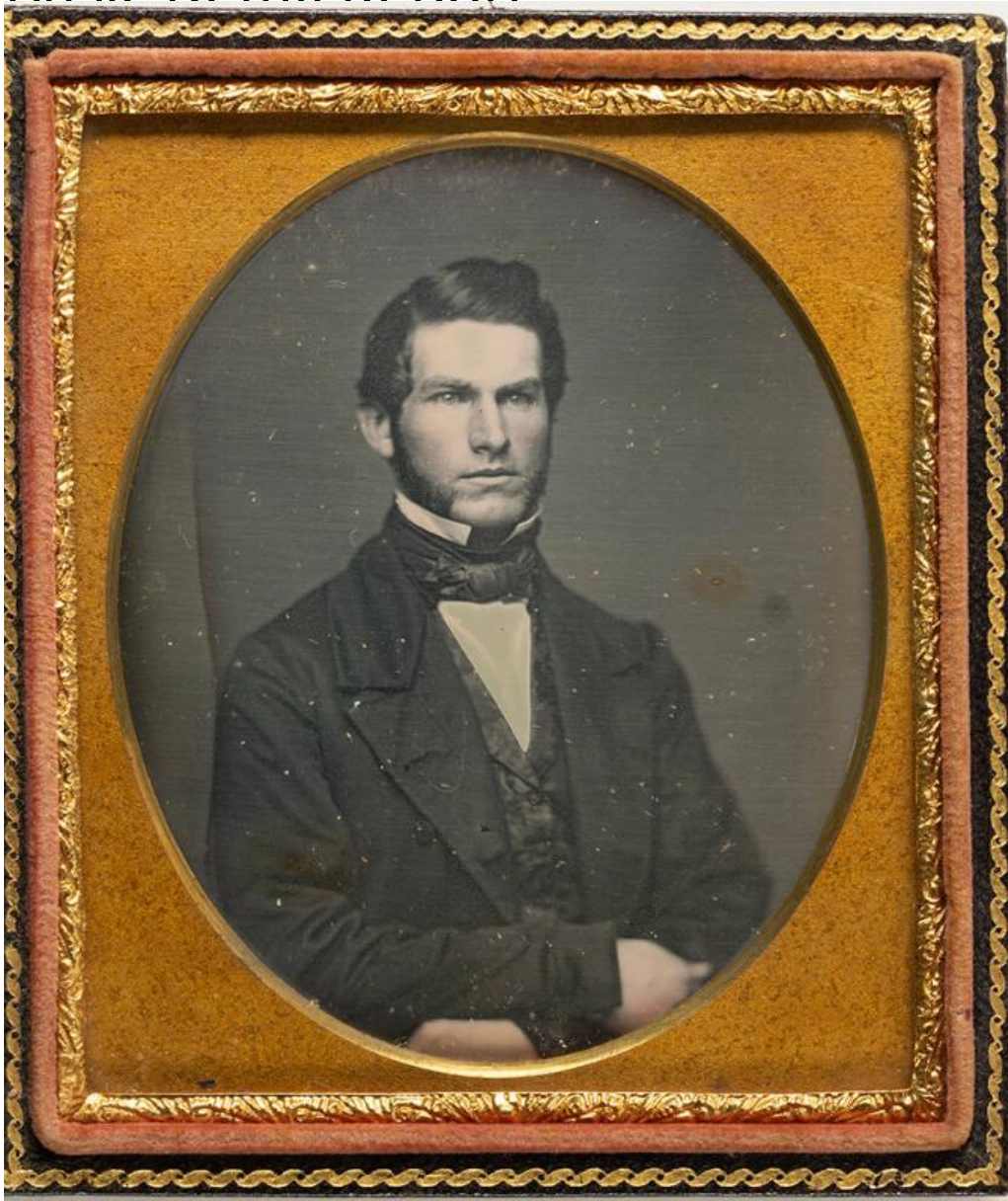


# Basic Detail Report

Medium Daguerreotype; silver-plated copper plate in brass mat package in  
tooled leather-covered wooden case; red velvet pad in left side of open case

Description Sixth plate daguerreotype by Major Moulthrop of B.L. Brown. Brown  
is in his late 20s or early 30s, and is wearing a jacket with wide lapels, a waistcoat

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with visible sheen, nap, or possibly pattern (brocade fabric?), a white shirt, an

upturned white collar, and a necktie tied in what appears to be a half-bow. His

arms are folded across his stomach. His hair is parted in the middle, with the top

fashioned into a low puff. His sideburns extend to his chin, and he has no other

facial hair.

height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ in. ( $9.2 \times 7.9 \times 1.3$ cm)
