Medium Daguerreotype; silver-plated copper plate in brass window mat

Description Bust-length sixth plate daguerreotype of Elizabeth Brinley, taken by an unknown photographer when she was in her late 20s or early to mid-30s. She

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is wearing what appears to be a robe (perhaps a kimono or kimono-like

garment) with very generous sleeves and a deep v neck, the clasp or belt out of

view. Beneath the robe is a white garment. Her hair is parted in the middle and

pulled back, her ears entirely visible.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. ( $8.3 \times 7$ cm) Other (height x

width x depth):  $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ in. ( $9.5 \times 8.3 \times 1.3$ cm)
