

# Basic Detail Report



**Title Henry Edward Chase**

Date 1860-1862

Primary Maker Henry Edward Chase

Medium Tintype; collodion on lacquered iron in brass mat package in tooled leather-covered wooden case. Embossed red velvet pad in left side of open case.

Description Sixth plate tintype of Henry Edward Chase at the age of about 4 or 5, taken by an unknown photographer. Chase is wearing a dress with buttons down the front and braid on either side of the buttons and on the skirt. His collar

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is funnel-shaped, and he wears a bow-tie and a Zouave-style hat. Notably, he is wearing a drum across his chest, and he is "playing" the drum with a drumstick in each hand.

Dimensions Plate (height x width):  $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. ( $8.3 \times 7$ cm) Other (case height x width x depth):  $3 \frac{5}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{8} \times \frac{5}{8}$ in. ( $9.2 \times 7.9 \times 1.6$ cm)
