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Description Sixth plate daguerreotype of Jane Elizabeth Bull Gilman (James Bidwell Gilman's wife). The velvet pad is embossed with the name "Brady's

Gallery," which suggests that the image was taken at Mathew Brady's studio.

Dimensions Plate (height x width): $3 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{3}{4}$ in. (8.3×7 cm) Other (case height x width x depth): $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{5}{8}$ in. ($9.5 \times 8.3 \times 1.6$ cm)
