The dog wears a collar with a buckle. A second child, probably a girl, wearing a

dress with a sash leans on her mother's lap. Flowers, apparently tulips, are in a

Chinese vase on the mantle of a fireplace in the right background. An oil painting

of a landscape in a wide gilt frame hangs from the paneled wall in the left

background.
