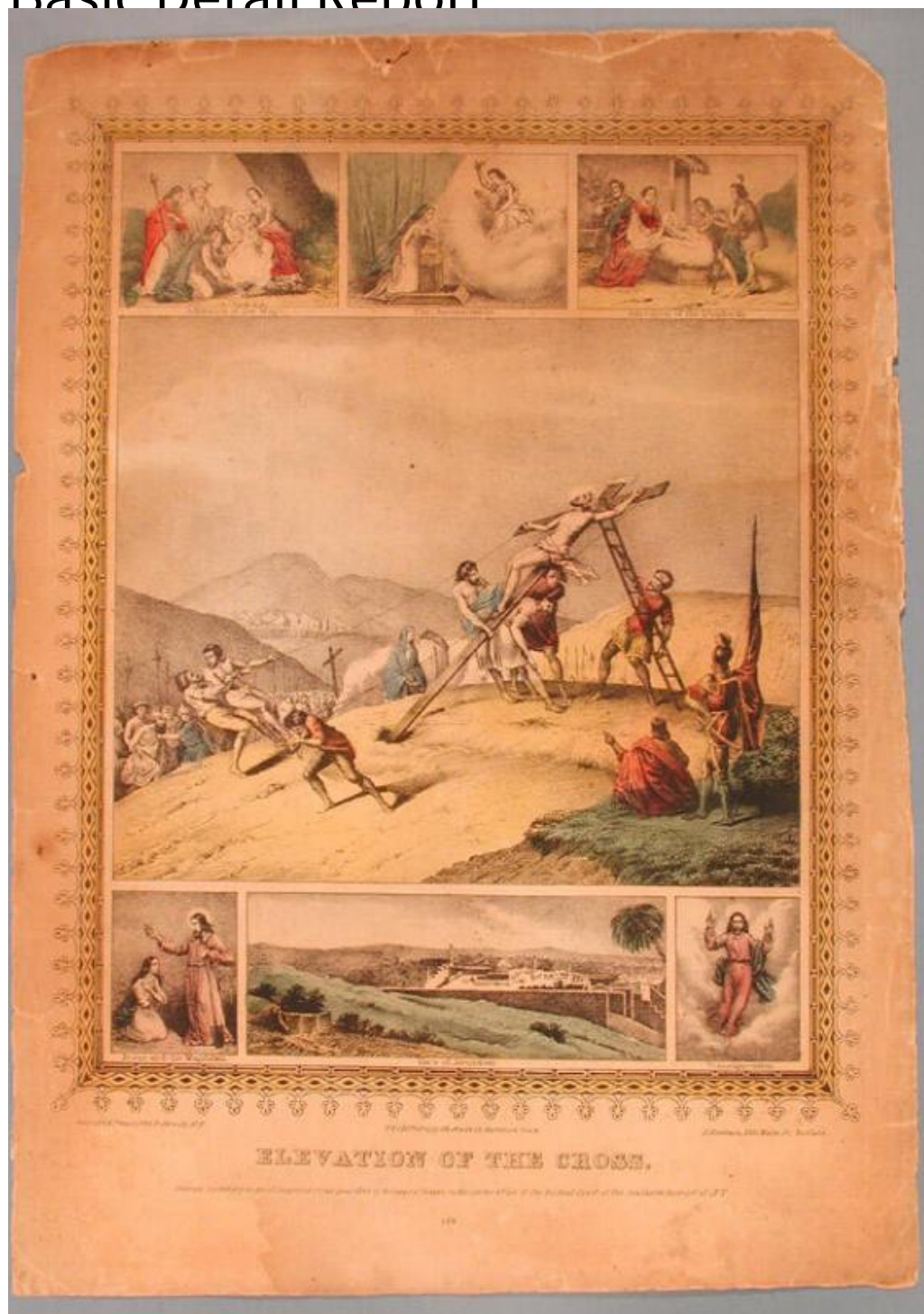

Basic Detail Report
