

# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Preserve Jar

Date late 19th century

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Wheel-thrown stoneware with a brown slip glaze

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Description Cylindrical, small-mouthed stoneware preserve jar with a brown slip glaze, or Albany-type slip glaze, on the interior and exterior. The cylindrical sides of the jar narrow at the shoulder then form a plain rim. An incised line circles the shoulder of the jar. There are small bumps in the glaze, as the stoneware below is not even. A group of short scratches in the glaze is visible near the bottom of the jar.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth):  $7 \frac{7}{16} \times 5 \frac{5}{16} \times 2 \frac{3}{8}$  in. (18.9 x 13.5 x 6cm)
