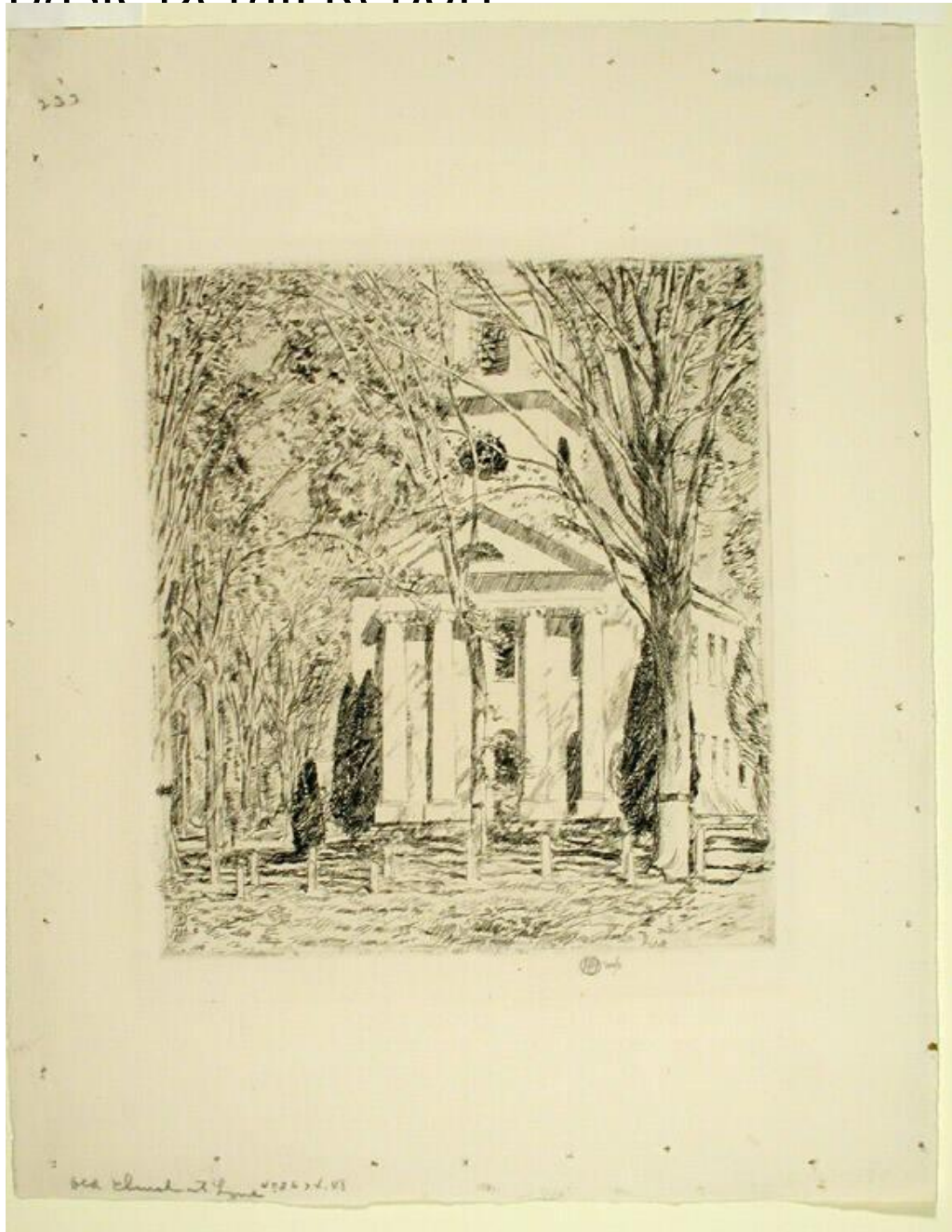

# Basic Detail Report

Description A church with a steeple and an Ionic portico is seen through trees, some of which appear to be elm trees. Several evergreens, probably cedars, are in the churchyard. A double row of fence posts is in the foreground.
