

# Basic Detail Report



**Title** Arthur E. Chase

**Date** 1860-1880

**Primary Maker** Unknown

**Medium** Tintype; collodion on lacquered iron in brass window mat package in tooled leather-covered wooden case. There is a Connecticut National Guard medal pinned to the embossed red velvet pad in the left side of the open case.

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Description Quarter plate tintype portrait of Arthur E. Chase, taken by an

unknown photographer. Chase is wearing a uniform and cap, presumably that of

the Connecticut National Guard. He is posing with his rifle. His facial hair is worn

in the chin curtain style. On the left side of the open case, there is a Connecticut

National Guard medal with the following inscribed on it: "ARTHUR E. CHASE /

Co. K 4th Regt. / C.N.G."
