

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Woman's Wedding Shoes and Shoe Holder

Date 5 June 1862

Primary Maker Bertha Olmstead

Medium Machine-stitched silk, cotton, and leather

Description Cream-colored satin slippers with flat soles and square toes. The throatline is square. The vamp is decorated with white silk ribbon bow. There is no center back seam, but two side seams. The upper is lined with plain-woven white cotton; the sock lining is also plain-woven white cotton. The throatline is bound with narrow silk tape. One end of a long loop of very narrow tape is stitched to either side of the slipper.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth): 1 7/8 x 2 1/2 x 9 3/8in.
