## Title Woman's Shoes

Date about 1895

Primary Maker Adabelle Canney Lyon

Medium Machine-stitched black leather and cotton, with silk ribbon and metal eyelets

Description Glossy black leather slipper with an unusual (for the period) low, stacked heel. The toes are oval and the throatline has a vestigial pointed tongue design. Black grosgrain ribbons lace through four metal eyelets across the foot. The upper is lined with white plain-woven cotton; the sock lining is also plain-woven white cotton. The soles are straight.
