Description Flood waters between brick buildings, probably commercial buildings. The building at left has a metal fire escape coming down the side. At right, one building has arched windows. Branches of leafless trees are visible. More leafless trees in the distance. White marks mostly in foreground are probably from marks on the film or the negative.
