

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Infant's Shoes

Date about 1680-1750

Primary Maker Tennant family

Medium Hand-stitched leather

Description Dark leather infant shoes, with a long tongue extending up the vamp to the ankle, and two punched tabs at the ankle, which originally would be held together with a small buckle. The tongue is flared wide at the top. The shoes are seamed only at the center back. The upper is turned out and stitched to the sole around the edges. The heel consists of a single layer of leather.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth): 2 1/4 x 1 3/4 x 4 1/4in.
