## Title Battle at Bunkers Hill. (Near Boston)

Date 1845

Medium Lithography; printer's ink and watercolor on wove paper mounted on board

Description Battle between British redcoat troops on the right and American soldiers on the left. A British soldier waves a red flag; American soldiers wave blue flags. A wounded American officer is on the ground in the foreground, supported by a comrade; a broken sword is below him on the ground. Other wounded and dead lie on the ground. An African American soldier with a musket is at the far right. Ships anchored in the harbor are in the background. Lower margin contains outline drawings of heads of participants, possibly to serve as a key to their identity. A man at the right is labeled: "Lieut. Pitcairn".
