

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Woman's Drawers

Date about 1890-1900

Primary Maker Emma Thomson

Medium Machine-stitched cotton, with cotton embroidery (possibly hand-stitched), and machine-made bobbin lace

Description Woman's white cotton drawers. The legs, which are separate and connected only at the waistband, are gathered into narrow cuffs embroidered with a featherstitch. A double ruffle edged with bobbin lace trims the bottom of the legs. The legs are gathered into a wide waistband, which closes with a white cotton tape tie. (One tie has been replaced with green bias tape.)
