

# Basic Detail Report

## Title Child's Pair of Sleeves

Date about 1830

Primary Maker Unknown

Medium Hand-stitched cotton and mother of pearl buttons

Description Child's detachable leg-o-mutton sleeves, made of white cotton with a woven checked design. The shoulder edge is gathered on a drawstring. The wrist opening is edged with scalloped whitework embroidery. The underarm seam is piped. A single mother of pearl button is stitched at the top of each sleeve.
