## Title Plate

Date 1830-1850

Primary Maker Staffordshire potteries

Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone with underglaze cobalt blue decoration

Description Round, ironstone plate with a transfer-printed underglaze cobalt blue pattern and border. The pattern, printed in the center of the plate, shows an impressive structure with a projecting portico, three-storys, and two long wings on either side. Several chimneys and a circular domed structure are visible on the roof. About seven individuals are walking on the flat lawn in front of the building, including women and children. The pattern is completely surrounded by a series of trees, branches, and flowers, then a field of dark blue at the rim. A series of parallel lines completes the border at the outer edge of the rim. There are many light scratches in the top surface of the plate, as well as three stilt marks.
