Title Cup Plates

Date about 1820-1840

Primary Maker Staffordshire potteries

Medium Molded buff-colored earthenware with a blue-tinted glaze and underglaze cobalt blue decoration

Description Two small cup plates made of buff-colored earthenware with a blue-tinted glaze, a type of ceramic known as pearlware. The hexagonal cup plates have a small transfer-printed cluster of flowers in the center, surrounded by a border of small scrolls and leaves. The rim of the plate has a raised pattern of leaves and ovals. Each cup plates has some worn areas on the rim and foot which have accumulated dirt over time.
