Medium Mechanically-molded ironstone with underglaze cobalt blue decoration

Description Round, ironstone plate with underglaze cobalt blue transfer-printed

borders and a pattern titled, "Trinity College, Hartford, Conn." The circular

pattern printed in the center of the plate shows a series of brick buildings with

towers, dormer windows, and gable roofs, all in the Gothic revival style. The

buildings are set back behind a grassy lawn lined with trees. The pattern is

surrounded by a border at the rim, with various large flowers and leaves on a

field of light blue. A narrow border at the outer edge of the rim consists of a

scalloped white line and a series of blue circles creating a geometric pattern.

There is light crazing over some of the top surface of the plate. There are several

areas of a yellow substance adhered to the bottom of the plate.
