Title Architectural Tiles

Date 1895-1910

Primary Maker The Hartford Faience Co.

Medium Press-molded earthenware with a maroon (.1) or blue-green (.2) glaze

Description Pair of square earthenware tiles, each made of different colored

earthenware and glaze. On each tile, the glazes are textured to give the

appearance of slight crazing and depth. Tile .1 consists of a dark red

earthenware with an opaque, matte, maroon glaze. The back of tile .1 is rough

and has three curved incised lines. Tile .2 consists of a buff-colored earthenware

with an opaque, matte, blue-green glaze. The back of tile .2 is relatively smooth.
