## Title Bookends

Date about 1935

Primary Maker Hawkinson Porcelain

Medium Mold-formed porcelain with a blue glaze

Description Heavy, rectangular porcelain bookends with a deep blue glaze. Each bookend, formed in one piece, consists of five equally-sized parts with a widely V-shaped top edge. Between each part is porcelain shaped like an inverted 'V'. The ends of each bookend are decorated with two semi-circular patterns that follow the V-shaped top edge of the bookend. The shape and color of each bookend reflect the Art Deco and streamlined styles popular during the 1920s, 1930s, and 1940s.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth of each bookend): 3 1/4 x 4 1/2 x 3 5/8in. (8.3 x 11.4 x 9.2cm)
