## Title Flowerpot

Date about 1850-1880

Primary Maker Edwin Roberts

Medium Wheel-thrown redware

Description Small, tapered, unglazed, redware flowerpot, the largest of a group of three graduated redware flowerpots. The flowerpot has a plain vertical rim, tapered, thin walls, and a flat bottom with a hole in the center. The flowerpot is slightly lopsided, and not completely round. The ceramic has darkened slightly on the bottom and on the top half.

Dimensions Primary Dimensions (height x width x depth):  $2 \frac{7}{8} \times 3 \frac{1}{2} \times 3 \frac{1}{8}$ in.
