Title Chamberstick

Date 1900-1950

Primary Maker Windsor Pewter

Medium Cast pewter

Description Cast pewter chamberstick consisting of a candlestick on a round tray with an elongated handle at one side. The chamberstick is constructed in three sections, a candlestick, a handle, and a tray, that fit around a metal rod that is held in place with a square bolt on the underside of the tray. The candlestick has a flared rim and a cylindrical top over a tapered section. Below this, at one side, is the handle, which ends in a ring with a flat thumbpiece on the top. The candlestick and handle sit at the top of a slight dome in the center of the tray. The tray dips down around the dome then rises up again to a plain rim. The chamberstick is lightly scratched and worn.
