Description Political map of the state of New York, with Lake Erie and Lake

Ontario on the north and west and Long Island to the south. Counties and towns

are shown on the main large map. Small inset maps show the cities of

Schenectady, Rochester, Troy, Buffalo, Albany, Brooklyn, Utica, Hudson, New

York City and Williamsburgh, divided into wards. The population of each ward,

town, and county is indicated. Some of the individual inset maps have arrows

indicating the direction of north. The orientation of these inset maps varies.
