Medium Photography; daguerreotype on silvered copper plate in leather-covered wood case with gilt mat

Description Half-length seated portrait of a young woman wearing a dress with a lace collar and a brooch. She is holding a bouquet of flowers, probably artificial flowers. Brass nonpareil mat has what appear to be fleurs de lis at the corners and other abstract floral designs at the edges. Red velvet pad has an embossed design of flowers in a vase surrounded by a floral border. Leather-covered case is blind-stamped with flowers in an oval surrounded by multiple borders. The gilt-stamping appears to represent a rope.
