Description Map of Norwich, Connecticut, with "Up-Town Plain" to the north, a stand of trees to the east, the Thames and Shetucket rivers to the south, and Yantic Cove to the west. The names of villages and physical features such as hills and rivers, and local roads with red squares on them indicating residences, public buildings and businesses are marked on the map in red. Notable landmarks include "an interloping r.r. of late date," "No-Mans Acre," "Savin-Hill," and "Chelsea Landing." Elevation is conveyed with hachure marks.
