Description Double-sided map and street directory of Newington, Connecticut.

The map, which is on a grid, extends from the town lines of West Hartford and

Hartford to the north, the town line of Wethersfield to the east, the town line of

Berlin to the south, and the town line of New Britain to the west. Streets,

schools, hospitals and parks and the Waterbury and New Haven lines of the New

York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad are labeled on the map. There are

several blue stars at various locations on the map that correspond to the

advertisements that appear around it. To the right of the map is a list containing

facts about the town. On the verso is the street index and more advertisements.
