Description Map of Deep River in the town of Saybrook, Connecticut, from the boundary line with the town of Chester to the northeast, Fountain Hill Cemetery to the southeast, an ivory goods factory to the southwest, and the Pratt Read and Company to the northwest. The Deep River runs roughly parallel to Main Street, with the Deep River Lumber Company, Pratt Read and Company, and C. B. Rogers' ivory goods factory all located along it. The streets are labeled and residences, public buildings and businesses are depicted with rectangles and labeled with the owner or occupant. Three cemeteries, a school and a Congregational Church are colored green.
