Description Map of Turkey Hills in what was Simsbury and is now East Granby, Connecticut, with Suffield to the north, Windsor to the east, John Griffin's land to the south, and Salmon Brook to the west. The land grants are divided with solid lines and contain the owner's name. The old boundary of Simsbury and the modern boundary of East Granby are both shown, as are roads in 1732. Natural features depicted include the Metacomet Ridge ridgeline, Salmon Brook, Stony Brook, and a waterfall.
