Description Map of most of New England, from the southern portions of

Vermont, New Hampshire and Maine to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the east,

Long Island and the Long Island Sound to the south, and New York State to the

west. It shows the trolley routes in, around and between New York, New York;

New Haven and Hartford, Connecticut; Springfield, Fitchburg, Worcester,

Boston, Lowell, and New Bedford, Massachusetts; Providence, Rhode Island;

Portsmouth, New Hampshire; and Portland, Maine. Open circles on the trolley

lines presumably denote stops. In the top left corner are inset maps of New York

City, Boston, and Portland, Maine. Natural features depicted include Mount

Tom, rivers, lakes and islands. Elevation is conveyed through hachure marks.
