**Title Harvard College Farms in the Pequot Country as laid out in 1658**

Description Copy of a map depicting the location of Harvard College's farms in New London County, Connecticut, and Washington County, Rhode Island. There are four numbered farms and two unnumbered ones, all of them depicted in green and labeled with the number of acres they contain. The map also shows the location of a Stonington-area meeting house in 1667, a fort fight in 1637, George Denison's house, and the Cheseborough house. Physical features depicted include elevation, conveyed through hachure marks; the Shonock River, Lambs Brook and other waterways; and what appears to be marshland.
