Description Map of the state of New York, with Upper Canada to the north;

Vermont, Massachusetts and Connecticut to the east; Pennsylvania and New

Jersey to the south; and Lake Erie to the west. The state is divided into counties,

with the locations of towns and cities appearing as numbered circles that

corresponds with the index that appears around the sides of the map. There is

an inset of the Greater New York City area. Physical features depicted include

elevation, conveyed with hachure marks; rivers; and lakes.
