## Title Mangled Automobile on Railroad Tracks

Description A badly smashed automobile is positioned immediately adjacent to railroad tracks. Very little of the exterior body of the car is visible; the chassis of the car is almost fully exposed, and it has been bent. In the background is a train locomotive on another track and a four-story brick building. Also in the background is a one-story frame building with this sign on it: "H. WHITE & CO. HAY, STRAW, GRAIN, AND FEED."
