Description Pocket map of New York State, with part of western Massachusetts and Connecticut to the east, Pennsylvania and New Jersey to the south, and Lakes Erie and Ontario to the west and northwest. The state is divided into townships, colored green, blue, pink, or peach. Towns are marked with circles and are labeled. The Erie Canal is shown on the map and in profile below it.
