Description A group of eleven or twelve people mill around in the woods, under or near a tarp that is suspended from a tree. Under the tarp there is a small table covered with various dishware and a loaf of bread. Antoinette Phelps Cheney leans over the table, on the left, holding something in her hands. There is a clothes line extending from a small sapling to the right. The line has one blanket or garment on it. The place depicted is in Keene Valley, New York.
