Description View of the exterior of one of the Cheney Brothers factories in South Manchester, Connecticut. The building is two stories tall. The upper level is shorter than the lower one. Behind the building, to the left, is another factory building. To the right of it is a tall circular tower or chimney that has scaffolding built around it. Another image has been superimposed over the main image. The details of that second image are unclear.
